Drive Defensively!

Proceed with caution to keep yourself and others safe on the road.





Maintain at least 3 seconds of distance behind the car in front of you. Increase distance for higher speeds, bad weather, and rough conditions.

Recognize signs of aggressive driving,

like speeding or racing, tailgating, or using vulgar comments or gestures. Keep calm, don't engage, and stay safe.

Expect the unexpected.
Even drivers with the best intentions make mistakes. Leave an exit path from your lane in case you need it. Turn into traffic carefully.

Watch your speed.
Faster speed = a
longer stopping time.
Slow down in bad
weather, congested
areas, and spots with
high pedestrian traffic.
